* Tadelakt is a lime plaster inspired by an ancient Moroccan tradition, similar in qualities to Marrakech lime: glossy and water-resistant.

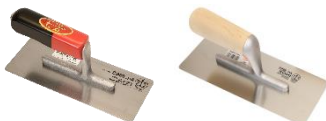
The use, preparation, application, and tools for the following products:

Tools that participants need to bring for the workshop:

- Work clothes, protective masks, safety glasses, latex or rubber gloves
- White cotton rags
- Steel trowel and venetian trowel



- 1 natural bristle brush, 2"
- 2 x 5-liter containers for mixing
- Stirring sticks

Samples created during the workshop

Depending on the capacity and interest of each participant: around 4 samples, including a colored sample chart.
